

# TISSUE TASSEL GARLAND

### Supplies & Tools Needed:

- \* 20x20 or 20x24  
Tissue Paper or Mylar Sheets
- \* String (Baker's twine or ribbon)
- \* Scissors
- \* Glue



### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Fold one sheet of tissue paper or mylar sheet in half horizontally and vertically.



2. Use your scissors to cut thin vertical strips. Note: Leave about 1 inch on top of the sheet (uncut).



3. Unfold each sheet, flatten all the strips out. Start rolling each paper from the uncut mid section.



4. Twist the mid section.



5. Twist the mid section around itself. Create a loop for hanging. Use a dab of glue to hold them together. Note: Let them dry before hanging.



6. Make as many tassels as you need. Use string (ribbon, baker's twine) to hang them.

Decorate your dessert table, balloons, drink station. The possibilities are endless!
